NEW YORK, N.Y. — Gary A. Leo became director of the Western Region, American Society for Technion-Israel Institute of Technology (ATS) as of March 1, 1987, it was announced by National Executive Vice President, Melvyn H. Bloom. Leo, until recently the executive director of the Jewish Community Center of San Diego, will head the Society's operations and fundraising activities for Southern California, Arizona, Nevada, New Mexico, Colorado and Hawaii from the Western Region headquarters in Los Angeles, Calif.

Prior to his post in San Diego, Leo was Assistant Executive Director of the JCC of Metropolitan Detroit and Assistant Professor of Education at Montclair State College in Upper Montclair, New Jersey. A graduate of Rutgers

University School of Social Work with an MSW degree, Leo received an M.A. degree from the School of Education, New York University, and a B.A. from Queens College.

Founded in 1940, American Society for Technion has played an increasingly important role in support of Israel's premier scientific and technological university. Over seventy per cent of all Israeli engineers and one-quarter of its scientists are Technion graduates. Technion, where more research and development activities are conducted than in all other Israeli universities combined, is key to Israel's ability to expand its industrial base, increase exports and gain economic stability.

The Society which is composed of eleven regions, 65 chapters and a Women's Division throughout the U.S., raised over \$21 million in fiscal 1986, an increase of 60 percent over a two year period. Technion's growing dependence on the Society's fundraising achievement has arisen due to major cutbacks by the Israel Government in its allocations to institutions of higher education.

Since its establishment, ATS has provided more than \$150 million for physical facilities, research teaching, student aid programs and equipment for the Institute in Haifa.

### ADL Praises Canada

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Abraham H. Foxman, associate national director of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, called the Canadian government's announcement that it will prosecute Nazi war criminals residing in that country "a commitment to securing justice and a warning that Canada will not allow itself to be a haven for Hitler's persecutors."

The Canadian government's action came following a comprehensive investigation by the Deschenes Commission which has already recommended 20 cases for criminal prosecution. Mr. Foxman, who also heads ADL's Inter-
