LAS VEGAS - Northwest Airlines will begin nonstop service between Las Vegas and Detroit effective June 1.

According to Jim Million, senior account manager, the new Northwest flight will leave Las Vegas at 1:30 p.m., arriving in Detroit at 8:05 p.m. Return service will leave Detroit at 10 a.m., arriving in Las Vegas at 11:05 a.m.

"Northwest operates a 248-flight-a-day traffic center at Detroit and, as a result, Las Vegas passengers can make connections to destinations throughout the northeast and Great Lakes regions," Million said.

With the new flight, Northwest will offer five daily departures from Las Vegas, including two roundtrips each to Minneapolis/St. Paul and Memphis and one to Detroit. All three destinations are Northwest traffic centers.

"By linking Las Vegas to Detroit as well as Minneapolis/St. Paul and Memphis, travelers will have easy access to more of Northwest's 135city route system," Million said.

Northwest serves destinations in 21 countries on three continents and carries more passengers across the Pacific than any other U.S. airline.


The opening in Warsaw coincided with the fifth World Congress of Polish Jewry which convened in Tel Aviv recently.
