BONN, (JTA) - Suspected Nazi war criminal Josef Schwammberger will be extradited to West Germany shortly to stand trial, Argentine officials promised the prosecutor's office in Stuttgart on Saturday.

They said their country gave high priority to West Germany's extradition request and that legal means appear to have been found to deprive Schwammberger of the Argentine citizenship he acquired nearly 40 years ago.

Schwammberger, 75, is believed to have been directly involved in the killings of at least 1,000 Jews in Nazi-occupied Poland in 1942 and 1943. Documentary evidence was brought to Argentina by a representative of the federal prosecutor's office on Nov. 26.

WASHINGTON, (JTA) - Secretary of State George Shultz said in his 1988 "State of the State Department" speech that the U.S.-Israel relationship is solid.

"Israel is a democratic country seeking stability and peace and the ability to pursue its destiny, and we support that country and we support those objectives and we work closely with Israel," Shultz said.

TEL AVIV, (JTA) - Ethiopia put about 20 Jews on trial last month for their involvement in attempting to immigrate to Israel, Israeli Immigration and Absorption Minister Yaacov Tsur said Monday.

His comments were reported in the newspaper Maariv, which added that nothing more is known of their fate. Tsur said that most of the defendants had worried relatives in Israel.

WASHINGTON (JTA) - Lawyers for Anne Henderson Pollard have filed suit with the U.S. Court of Appeals in Washington in an attempt to reverse federal district court Judge Aubrey Robinson's Dec. 6 ruling denying Pollard medical treatment by her family doctors.

Pollard, who claims to be suffering from various digestive disorders, is serving a five-year prison sentence for being an "accessory" to a scheme in which her husband, Jonathan Pollard. a former U.S. Navy intelligence analyst, passed classified documents to a renegade Israeli espionage team.

The lawsuit also seeks a reduction of Anne Pollard's sentence on humanitarian grounds.

WASHINGTON, (JTA) - In a televised New Year's Day greeting broadcast in the Soviet Union, President Reagan addressed American concerns about human rights, but did not specifically mention the plight of Soviet Jews denied permission to emigrate.

"As you know, we Americans are concerned about human rights, including freedom of speech, press, worship and travel," Reagan said. "Silence is a falsehood. We will always speak out on behalf of human dignity."

Reagan also gave Soviet viewers a look at how Chanukah and Christmas are celebrated in the United States - a look that may have surprised Americans, as well as their Jewish and non-Jewish counterparts in the Soviet Union.
