

Radio Personality Bob Grant To Host 40th Independence Anniversary Celebration Tour To Israel



NEW YORK — Bob Grant, WABC's prime-time radio talk-show host, is leading a 40th anniversary of independence celebration tour to Israel.

The twelve-day tour, in conjunction with Pathway Travel, New York, leaves on February 17th, with round-trip, nonstop air service via TWA plus five-star hotel and accommodations with breakfast. The fully guided and comprehensive tour will include Jerusalem, Haifa, Tiberias and Tel-Aviv.

Based on his long familiarity with Israel, Grant has personally selected all the activities, and will be taping special guest interviews and discussions with Israel government officials and journalists. Grant will accompany the group throughout the entire tour, and will host two cocktail parties and dinners.

The full, all-inclusive tour will cost \$1,449 per person person, double occupancy. The itinerary begins with an in-depth tour of Jerusalem, including the Hebrew University, Mount Scopus, the Mount of Olives and beautiful panoramic views. Other stops include the old city's Jaffa Gate, the restored Jewish quarter, the Temple Mount and Western Wall - Judaism's holiest place — plus a walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

The tour then continues into the Judean Desert, with a cable ride at Masada and a dip into the Dead Sea, a visit to Jericho and a Kibbutz

Greek Opposition Leader Calls For Full Recognition Of Israel

ATHENS, (JTA) — The leader of Greece's largest opposition party called on the government recently to extend full diplomatic recognition to Israel immediately, or certainly before Greece assumes the rotating presidency of the European Economic Community on July 1.

Konstantinos Mitsotakis, head of the New Democracy Party, said if the government fails to do this, his party would recognize Israel the moment it comes to power.

Konstantinos spoke at a meeting with Israel's diplomatic representative in Greece, Moshe Gilboa. Gilboa holds the rank of ambassador, but Greek relations with Israel are only on the consular level.
