The 24th annual Salute to Israel Parade will take place on April 17th, 1988 -- Rosh Chodesh Iyar 5748 -- at 12:00 noon, on Fifth Avenue in New York City.

The Parade will be the central event inaugurating citywide celebrations of Israel's 40th year of independence. This year's Parade will depict Israel's history chronologically, from pre-State activity to the present-day. Each participating marching group will present a single event, milestone, or achievement from within Israel's history. Via colorful banners, creative props, and dramatic costumes, the groups will bring their themes to life on Fifth Avenue. The final result will be a highly organized and high educational "pageantlike" tribute to Israel, in this, her 40th year.

Immediately following the Parade will be a unique 40th-Anniversary celebration -- Israel-Fest -- to be held at the 7th Regiment Armory, on Park Avenue at 67th Street. A capacity crowd of 15-20,000 people are expected at this festive event, which will feature top Israeli singers, dancers, actors, storytellers, clowns, and puppeteers. Displays and booths will offer a wide range of Israeli products, while "Rehjob Dizengoff," our special cafe, will feature a potpourri of Israeli foods to delight your senses.

All Jewish communities should share the festivities on April 17th, 1988! Join us in honoring Israel at 40!
