# Three Israelis Killed

## Las Vegas To Celebrate Israel's 40th Birthday -- At Inter-Expo

Israel turns 40 this year and to recognize this special occasion, the Council of Jewish Organizations of the Jewish Federation of Las Vegas is planning a community-wide celebration.

The festival will be on Sunday, April 24, at Inter-Expo, from 12 - 5 p.m. Located on the corner of Sunset and Bermuda Road at the Hughes Airport Center, Inter-Expo offers merchandise and hand-crafts from Israel and the Middle East, Latin America, the Orient and Europe.

Las Vegas will be able to "shop the world" and at the same time enjoy entertainment, refreshments, a walk-a-thon and booths with displays and cultural items for sale.

Israel Independence Day is actually Thursday, April 21. However the celebration in Las Vegas will be on Sunday to allow for total community involvement.

"More than three thousand participants will

TEL AVIV (JTA) Three Israeli civilians were killed and 10 wounded recently in a three-and-a-half hour terrorist bus hijack and shooting rampage in the Negev.

Two women and a man, all passengers in the bus, were fatally shot. The man was killed by the terrorists while senior Israel Defense Force officers were bargaining with them to gain time. The women were killed by bullets later, as border police stormed the bus. According to the IDF, they were fired upon by the terrorists, all three of whom were killed by border police.

The dead Israelis were identified as Victor Ramm, 39, an engineer and father of three children whose mother died six months ago; Miriam Ben-Meir, 46, a mother of four children;
