MONTREAL (JTA) -Immigration Minister Benoit Bouchard announced that the government will continue deportation proceedings against convicted Palestinian terrorist Mohammed Mahmoud Issa, who en-

tered Canada a year ago with an immigrant visa he obtained under false pretenses.

Issa is due to appear before a federal court in Ottawa for a hearing. But for a time, his deportation had seemed moot.

Instead of showing up at immigration court in Hamilton, Ontario, as scheduled, declared he was leaving Canada voluntarily and he and his family boarded a flight to Algeria.




Issa was convicted in Greece for the 1968 bombing of an Israeli airliner at Athens airport in which one man was killed.
