## Shultz And Shevardnadze To Confer On Mideast Peace Plan, Human Rights

three days of meetings began. She said the Soviets see it as a "plenary conference," where the five United Nations Security Council members could impose a solution.

The United States and Israel, however, view the conference as a ceremonial meeting that would not have the power to dictate a resolution. It would occur two weeks prior to the first round of Arab-Israeli negotiations on instituting autonomy measures on the West Bank and Gaza Strip.

"We proposed a conference that is not able to impose solutions on the parties, not able to veto any agreements that are made by the parties, but is a vehicle for getting negotiations started," Shultz said on NBC-TV's "Meet the Press." He noted that the United States vetoed the Soviet concept when Moscow offered it as a United Nations Security Council resolution.

Israeli Prime Minister

Yitzhak Shamir noted that while he opposes an international conference, he had consented to negotiations under superpower sponsorship when proposed by Shultz before the Washington summit last December. But King Hussein of Jordan rejected it.


