
## Shake, Rattle & Roll At Bally's April 1, 2 & 3

Chuck Berry's music, lyrics and free spirit have made an indelible impression on millions of people, including the Beatles and Rolling Stones. He was part of the birth of Rock and Roll in the mid 50's and he still remains one of its most superbly exciting performers. Even today his music exerts an enormous influence on Rock and Roll fans.

Included among his greatest hits are: "Roll Over Beethoven" and "Rock and Roll Music," both of which the Beatles later recorded; "Round and Round," "Carol," "You Can't Catch Me," "Johnny B. Goode," "Sweet Little Sixteen," "Nadine," "No Particular Place to Go," "Back In The USA" and "Reelin' and Rockin'."

Teenagers who weren't even born when Berry had his first hit, now seek his autograph. They know all the words to his songs, Berry often has 10 to 15 thousand voices singing along with him in concert.

Sharing the stage with Berry is the energetic and talented rock and roller Jerry Lee Lewis.

Born in 1935, Jerry lee Lewis began "pounding the piano" when he was eight years old. A "selfstyled" rocker on the piano, Jerry Lee's music is known throughout the world.

Some of his hits include "Whole Lot of Shakin," "Great Balls of Fire," "Chantilly Lace" and "I'm Just Rockin My Life Away."

One of Lewis' more unusual honors was having his most famous recordings included in a time capsule on the moon by Neil Armstrong and his Apollo Crewmembers in 1969.
