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A new survey out of New York could cause worries for Las Vegas resorts who want people to play, play, play. Titled "Americans and the Arts V." sponsored by a tobacco company and conducted by the National Research Center of the Arts, an affiliate of Louis Harris & Associates, the study found that time spent working has gone up since 1973 and play time has been shrinking. 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
