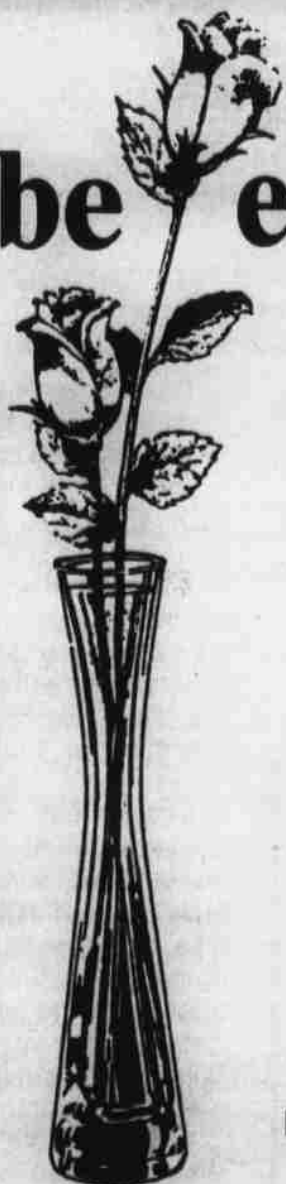
'NFTY at 50' — How UAHC Is Bringing Young People Closer To Jewish Life
