We must try to strike a balance between our "Yetzer Tov" (good inclination) - love of G-d, pursuit of Justice and Holiness; and our "Yetzer Ha'rah" (evil inclination) - the aggressive instinct within us that can either cause us to build or to destroy, the pursuit of the material things life has to offer. Without both, we would not truly be able to live our lives to the fullest. We would not be human.

I would like to close with a beautiful quote from the Mahzor Hadash:

"There is holiness when we strive to be true to the best we know.

There is holiness when we are kind to someone who cannot possibly be of service to us.
