At 11 a.m. on Sunday, May 14, 1989, an annual walk-a-thon will be held as a prelude to day-long activities celebrating the forty first birthday of the independence of the State of Israel.

Entitled "Las Vegas Super Walk '89", this annual event will mark the third walk-a-thon sponsored by the Nate Mack B'nai B'rith Lodge, the Jewish Federation of Las Vegas, B'nai B'rith Youth Organizations, Black Tie Optional, the Las Vegas Jewish Singles, and numerous Temple youth organizations.

The two-mile walk will commence from the Inter Expo Building, 6600 Bermuda Rd. (Bermuda and Sunset) and continue east to the Sunset P.O. and then return to the starting point. In consideration for seniors and children, they will start at the P.O. and walk one mile west to the Inter Expo Building. 7-Up will provide refreshments and assist in promoting the event as a community wide service project.

At 10:30 a.m., preceding the walk, a brief orientation will be held for all walkers. At the conclusion of the walk at approximately noon time, raffle drawings will be held to give away many prizes. Although there is no charge to walk, walkers and non-walkers alike are encouraged to purchase raffle tickets at \$2.00 each to defray expenses and provide for next year's event. Winners need not be present to win and prizes may be picked up at the Jewish Federation office.

Sunshine Bus Information For Seniors

The \$15,000 van will be used by the Sunshine Bus Committee to provide transportation for senior citizens and handicapped people in Las Vegas. The van was purchased with Federal Urban Mass Transportation funds provided by NDOT.

The Sunshine Bus administers a program to provide social outlets, recreation, and other needed transportation to isolated senior citizens. It operates with seven vehicles, a staff of two persons, and many dedicated volunteers. The service provides transportation for grocery and personal shopping, the Community food bank, senior citizens centers, club meetings, and the Howard W. Cannon Senior Service Center.

The Sunshine Bus provides round-trip service. The driver or an escort is available to assist the individual who may require help with shopping. For persons confined to wheelchairs, two vehicles are equipped with lifts. Any person over the age of 60 may use the Sunshine Bus.

In November, Mr. Jack Binion donated two vehicles to the Sunshine Bus Committee on behalf of Binion's Horseshoe Hotel and Casino. The total number of buses is now seven, with all being in demand.
