"The Riviera is going to be the largest and most sensational property in Las Vegas, and these changes will allow us to concentrate on those areas that will allow us to grow dramatically, but at the same time continue to operate smoothly during the expansion," Waltzman said.

Odents has been with the Riviera for 41/2 years after serving as general manager for several hotels in Israel. He also oversaw the construction of a number of hotels in several nations, including Ramada and Sheraton properties.

The Riviera will be going through the most challenging period in its 34-year history in the next few years, Riklis said.

He pointed out that when the expansion is complete, the Riviera will boast nearly 4,000 guest rooms and suites, a 125,000-square-foot casino. four showrooms, two 200-seat lounges, 12 restaurants, more than 250,000 square feet of convention and meeting space and a 43-story tower, by far the tallest hotel in Nevada.
