Marilyn (Micki) Waller, 60, died at her home recently of cancer.

She moved to Las Vegas in 1963 from New York where she was born Jan. 25, 1929, in Brooklyn.

Waller was active in golf and tennis clubs at the Las Vegas Country Club. She founded the Bowling League at Temple Beth Sholom and launched the Jewish Federation Golf Tournament.

Waller entered the real estate field 10 years ago and worked for Jack Matthews Co. at the time of her death. She was consistently chosen to participate in the firm's million dollar club. Participants in the organization must sell more than a million dollars in property each year.

"It's hard to say what she'll be remembered most for," said her daughter, Beth Kamhi. "She was just a real special person and she touched a lot of people.

"She had a basic integrity about life in general whether sports or business," Kamhi said. "She was just an easy person to work with."

Despite her illness, Micki won Jack Matthews' Outstanding Production Award in 1988.

In sports Waller was the recipient of more than two dozen trophies from local civic groups for tennis and bowling.

She served on the board of Women's Division of the Jewish Federation, and was active in Sisterhood of Temple Beth Sholom where she helped found the Mr. and Mrs. Club.

Waller is survived by her husband, Irving Waller; three children, Greg Waller of Lexington, Ky., Andrea Waller Miera of Las Vegas, and Beth Kamhi of Chicago, six grandchildren, Moby and Graham Waller, Max and Casey Michelle Miera, Matt and Reva Kamhi; and two brothers; Robert Beckwith of Las Vegas and Jerry Beckwith of Poughkeepskie, N.Y.
