Tax Tip For Seniors Reid Handout Offers Helpful Tax Advice

Author of the 1988 Taxpayer Bill of Rights, Reid is a long term champion of the average citizen over the tax bureaucracy. His handout entitled *Protecting Older Americans Against Overpayment of Income Taxes* is designed to help seniors understand and prepare their 1995 tax return. In simple terms, it answers questions most commonly asked about forms, credits, deductions and exemptions.

"This informational brochure leads seniors through the confusing maze of IRS rules and procedures," Reid said. "Many older Americans overpay their taxes because they do not have important information. This handy guide takes seniors through all the steps of preparing their returns and even includes a list of toll-free numbers and free publications to help them get the answers they need. I hope Nevada seniors will share my special tax information paper with relatives and friends."

As a member of the Senate Special Committee on Aging, Reid has fought to protect senior citizens' rights for years.
