Clinton Praises Energy, Belief, Conviction, Passion Of UJA Young Leadership Conference Participants

WASHINGTON, DC - By the time President Clinton took the stage during the first night ceremonies of the 3-day UJA Young Leadership Conference, the 3,000 25-45 year old Jewish activists from across the country were primed. Earlier in the day they had heard Malcolm Hoenlein, executive vice-chair of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, exhort them to bring a distinctly Jewish brand of activism into the public arena. And that's just what they intended.


The cheers from the overflow crowd astounded even Clinton, who was making his first U.S. appearance after returning from the "Summit of the Peacemakers" in Egypt and a stopover in Israel. "I've been trying to convince everyone else in Washington to delay the onset of this year's campaign, and you aren't helping very much. But you have my permission."

On a more serious note, Clinton said: "We have resolved to strengthen our cooperation with all those who will stand against terror in the Middle East. We are committing more than \$100 million to the task. We are increasing our intelligence sharings and we are developing new methods to combat violence there. We are convinced that, ultimately, fear will overcome the adversity of terror, because overcoming that kind of adversity is the genius of the
