Former Mossad Head Distrusts Assad

JERUSALEM, Israel (JTA) – The former head of the Mossad, Israel's foreign intelligence agency, recently said that he was not convinced Syrian President Hafez Assad was serious about making peace with Israel.

"We still have to look for signs that President Assad really wants a genuine peace with the State of Israel," Shabtai Shavit told reporters. "I am still not totally convinced that [Assad] has made the required change of direction to achieve a sincere and genuine peace."

His remarks contrast sharply with the assessment of the former head of army intelligence, Uri Saguy.

Saguy said Assad was pragmatic, and that after the breakup of the Soviet Union he made a strategic decision to pursue peace, as a means to regain possession of the Golan Heights.

Shavit served as head of the Mossad for 7 years. His successor, Maj. Gen. Danny Yatom, was the prime minister's military secretary.

Roman Mosaic Floors Archaeologists

JERUSALEM, Israel (JTA) -Archaeologists have discovered a 216square-yard Roman mosaic in the Israeli city of Lod.

The Roman mosaic, which dates back to the third or fourth century and which is the largest ever found in Israel, was uncovered in excavations preceding work to widen a road.

The mosaic was found in near-perfect condition.

Animal and fish motifs appear in the mosaic, leading archaeologists to believe it was the decorative part of a floor in a private villa.

"There were no inscriptions found at all," said Miriam Avissar, one of the archaeologists who worked at the site. "The floor itself is extraordinary. There are images of all kinds of animals: giraffes, lions, gazelles, different animals attacking others and fish from the Mediterranean region.

"There is also a ship, a merchant ship, in the floor.

Avissar added that the Israeli Antiquities Authority recommended that the site be turned into a museum.

"But until some source of funding is found for that, nothing can be done," she said.
