## LAS VEGAS IS ON THE BOOM

Great Business Activity in Salt Lake Route City.

### MANY IMPROVEMENTS.

#### Angels Gush Over Hospitality of the Saints.

Las Vegas is fast taking on the airs of a city, according to the report brought in by Attorney C. O. Whittemore, who just returned yesterday morning from an extended visit in Las Vegas and Los Angeles. He was accompanied north by J. Ross Clark, who continued on toward the east. Mr. Clark met Senator W. A. Clark at Ogden on his arrival from Butte, and the two took the Union Pacific for the east.

"I was in Los Angeles together with W. H. Bancroft," Mr. Whittemore said, "for the purpose of attending the meeting of the Las Vegas Townsite company directors. At the meeting it was decided to spend \$50,000 at once in public improvements. These will include a waterworks system large enough for a city of 20,000 population, with six and eight-inch mains for the principal streets. The main streets will be graded and paved also, gravel and oil being used for this purpose. Stone curbing will be used for the business streets and redwood curbing in the residence district."

"Las Vegas is now the center of surprising business activity. Large quantities of freight are being handled there. It is forwarded from this point to all the Bullfrog and other mining districts in southern Nevada. Building is going forward—large structures are springing up as if by magic. Three or four large business houses are in course of construction, besides some

thirty smaller business houses. There are at least 2,000 persons in Las Vegas at this time, compared with less than 500 a month ago. The place seems destined to be by all odds the most important business point between Los Angeles and Salt Lake.

#### TOWN LOTS ADVANCE.

"Lots in the town are being transferred at an advance of 100 per cent over the price charged by the company a short time ago. The company will deliver deeds to the property disposed of some time ago between July 10 and July 15."

Speaking of the visit of the Angels to Salt Lake, Mr. Whittemore said:

"Practically all the visitors had reached home before I left Los Angeles. With one voice they are singing the praise of Salt Lake. They say openly that they never had such entertainment anywhere before, and never heard of such hospitality as extended them by the citizens of Salt Lake. They are profuse in their praise. The visitors will do Salt Lake an immense amount of good, and the benefit will reach over many years."

"The business of the Salt Lake Route is advancing ever day," Mr. Whittemore continued. "The passenger business is far beyond what was anticipated. The freight business is all that was expected, and it is growing so nicely that everybody connected with the road is enthusiastic."—Salt Lake Herald.

## IT IS A BIG RUSH

A Graphic Description of the Hustle, Rustle and Bustle at Crescent.

### GOOD MINERAL EVIDENCE

The Town is Located One Night and the Following Day Has Auto Service.

### WORK WILL DEMONSTRATE

CRESCENT, Nevada, June 26, 1905. We doubt if there was ever a mining camp located in one night and have automobiles unloading gold seekers into it the following day, but such is the record of the new camp of Crescent. Yesterday there were a few tents in evidence, such as those occupied by the prospector; this morning every knoll has its occupant and is dotted with the canvas shroud, giving evidence of the thrift and push of the western adventurer, found in all Nevada mining rushes.

This morning, as we rise with the sun, there are five flaps to as many tents thrown back to invite the gold seeker to as many third parlors where liquor is dispensed at the usual price, 12 1/2 cents per. There is not an accommodation for the weary traveler other than what is brought in by him. The automobiles make regular trips. Nearly the whole of Las Vegas came in on the rush, and the regular stage with fare at \$1 a piece was not fast enough for them, but with Cleveland of the Cleveland Lumber Co., in the front seat came leading into camp the first auto, at the price of \$2 a piece, and they kept coming in a long time after dark and the auto made regular and very fast trips between this place and the station, I would say every hour.

Town lots are on the increase in price from one day to that of another, but there is seemingly no demand for them other than to use them temporarily, but even for all that there are some few transfers in dirt being made. Last night every gulch or eminence, bright as they would be called in Vegas, had its occupant. Where everybody came

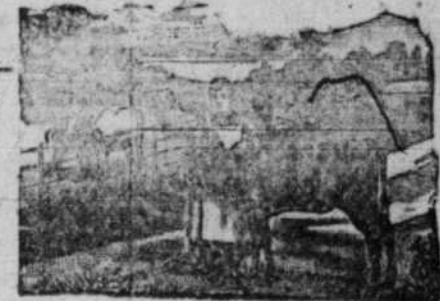
