# LAS VEGAS IS

Great Business Activity in Salt Lake Route City.

Angela Gush Over Hospitality of the Saints.

Las Vegas is fast taking on the airs of a city, according to the report brought in by Attorney C. O. Whitte more, who just returned yesterday morning from an extended visit in Las Vegas and Los Angeles. He was ac companied north by J. Ross Clark, who continued on towend albe east. Mr Clark met Senator W. A. Clark at Og den on his arrival from Butte, and the two took the Union Pacific for the east. "I was in Los Augeles together with W. H. Bancroft," Mr. Whittemore said, 'for the purpose of attending the meeting of the Las Vegas Townsite company directors. At the meeting it

was decided to spend \$50,000 at once in public improvements. These will include a waterworks system large enough for a city of 20,000 population. with six and eight-inch mains for the principal streets. The main streets will be graded and paved also, grave and oil being used for this purpose. Stone curbing will be used for the business streets and redwood curbing

"Las Vegas is now the center of surprising business activity. Large quantities of freight are being handled there. It is forwarded from this point to all the Bullfrog and other mining districts in southern Nevada. Building is going forward-large structures are sprining up as if by magic. Three or four large business houses are in NEVADA course of construction, besides some

in the residence districts.

thirty smaller business houses. There are at least-2,000 persons in Las Vegas ARMOUR'S at this time, compared with less than 500 a month ago. The place seems destined to be by all odds the most important business point between Los Angeles and Salt Lake.

TOWN LOTS ADDVANCE.

"Lots in the town are being trans: ferred at an advance of 100 per cent over the price charged by the company a short time ago. The company will IMPROVEMENTS, deliver deeds to the property disposed of some time ago between July 10 and July 15."
