The last session of the legislature appropriated \$1,000. for Lincoln county to be applied in securing a water station or stations along the arid wester of travel but conditioned it upon a baisis that requires a flow of fou barrels of water in eve y twenty-four hours before it can be applied for such of the county commissioners in re' spons to the petitions made the ap propriation to test for water to the end that this date fund may become opera live and thus increase the water station to the south of Vegas.

The commissioners as faithfu guardians of the foterests of a peopl acted wisely in making this appropratio: for preliminary tests. The locating and securing an ample supply of water alon; this route means much for the prespec tors and the upbuilding of Lincoln county resources. The expenitdure o this money in a judicious application t facilitate travel and development will bring returns manifold.
