VALUE OF OIL

In view of the possible existence of oil at Indian Creek, the following article will be interesting:

Sixteen tons of 15 degrees gravity oil generates, it is estimated, as much steam as 25 tons of the best Welsh coal. The evaporation per pound of coal at 212 degrees is 9 pounds; the evaporation per pound of oil at 212 degrees is 15 pounds; thus 1,362 pounds of oil are equivalent to 2,040 pounds of coal, which gives a ratio of efficiency of oil to coal of 1.65 to 1. One hundred and four barrels of oil equals 25 tons in heating power. One barrel of oil weighs about 300 pounds; one barrel is equal to 42 gallons.

One of the ferry boats uses 143 barrels of oil in 48 hours; formerly the same boat used 40 tons of coal to do the same work. According to this, 3 1/4 barrels of oil are equal to a ton of coal, or, in round numbers, 40 tons of coal are worth about \$240; 143 barrels of oil are worth about \$110, a saving of about \$130, or over 20 per cent. The use of oil in marine boilers is increasing rapidly. There are 200 vessels, with San Francisco as a home port, that use oil. And it is said 20,000 locomotives in the United States are being changed from coal to oil burners.

SCHWAB'S KICK

The New York Journal of Commerce speaking by authority for Charles M. Schwab, says: "The sensational statement regarding fabulous profits made by Mr. Schwab in Nevada mines are characterized as grossly exaggerated, whilst reports of his intention to consolidate twenty or thirty companies, more or less, in Bullfrog and other districts, were authoritatively stated to a representative of this journal to be very much beside the truth. Mr. Schwab does not relish the use of his name to boom properties with which he is in no way connected."

COPPER CAMP

James Cronan, an old pioneer miner, returned from White Pine county last week. He says the great low grade copper deposits around Ely are about to be developed by companies of financial abilities. Smelters will be erected to treat the ore on a large scale.

The greatest copper mines of the West yield from five to ten per cent copper. The Ely camp will not run more than three per cent, but the great ore bodies can be treated profitably because of transportation and other facilities.
