**Alien's Rights**

The question of an alien's rights to hold mining claims has been discussed in Manhattan considerably of late. A pretty good authority on mining laws asserts that this question has been settled by a decision of the supreme court in which it is held that an alien has all the rights of a citizen in the matter of locating and handling mining claims. The only difference cited is that upon application for a patent an alien must declare his intention of becoming a citizen of the United States before a patent will be issued by the government.—Mail.

**Indian Rights**

In the Nye county District Court Judge Breen has held, in overruling a demurrer in the suit of Johnnie Peavine vs. Ed. Clifford et al., that an Indian can own and hold real estate in the form of claims, sue and be sued the same as other citizens of this country.
