Colorado Capital Seeking Investment

Charles Scheu, who has been one of the fortunate ones in the recently re-vealed mining district of Good Springs, came in from that interesting region Thursday morning, all the more impressed with the future of the mining industry in that locality, says the Salt Lake Tribune.

He says that during the past few weeks there has been a steady influx of Colorado mining and investment talent, who have lost no time in going over the district thoroughly in search of properties which are open either for cash sales or options. This crowding in of capital is having a most beneficial effect upon the region, and much more money is waiting for Good Springs propositions than ever before in its more recent history.

Mr. Scheu states that there are several more properties which will soon be counted in on the list of contributors of rich lead and copper ores. Several are now making preparations to ship, among which may be mentioned the Columbus Copper and Ninety-nine companies. The Ninety-nine group must cover a distance of twenty-one miles from the mine to the railroad tracks, yet this distance is not much of a barrier to the company.

There is considerable confidence expressed, he says, in the district over the early beginning of work upon the Good Springs smelter. The delay in pushing this work has not discouraged the owners of property, and they are anxious of getting all prepared for the start when it is ready to enter upon its life of usefulness.
