### WILD ROSE MINES

Notes from the Famous Panamint Gold Camps

[Special Correspondence]

Twenty-eight thousand dollars worth of mining supplies, consisting of tools, powder, lumber, etc., are on the road from Los Angeles, consigned to the Skidoo Mining Company, controlled by Bob Montgomery and associates. This property is known as the Emigrant Springs strike, Wild Rose District.

Twenty miners are now working on the Skidoo and thirty more will be employed as quickly as tools can be secured.

Average values of \$79 to the ton in gold have been secured from 317 assays taken from the various ledges owned by Skidoo Mining Company.

Mat Hoveck, general manager of the Skidoo property, now has a "white steamer" for his work in the Wild Rose District.

Engineer W. B. Gray is just in from the Wild Rose Mining Company's property. He reports rapid progress on that promising property. The road has been completed from Harrisburg to the camp, which is one and one-half miles easterly. Some heavy work was found necessary.

Work on Tunnel No. 1 is going on with entire satisfaction. Cut and tunnel is now in about 25 feet. Tunnel will be in milling values. The working force will be increased at once.

Engineer E. J. Waugh, who has been in Wild Rose for last month, looked over the property of the Wild Rose Mining Co., and was so well impressed with the surface showings and general indications for permanency that he took a block of treasury stock.

W. H. Sanders, who is largely interested in Wild Rose District, returned to camp this week.

The Desert Rose Mining Company is the latest organization to begin business in the Wild Rose District. This corporation has been organized by banking and mining men of Beatty and Rhyolite. The company has recently acquired valuable properties near the Skidoo. Work will begin without delay.

A word of warning should be said to parties going into Wild Rose District before fall. The water supply is undeveloped. While it is known that there is a quantity of water available, which will be piped to the various localities, including the new townsite of Wild Rose, as yet this has not been done. Pipe is ordered and extensive development along these lines is under way. At present time there is a limited supply of water at Emigrant Springs.

Chafey & Probaseo are developing water for the new town of Wildrose but it will be some weeks before the pipe is laid.

It is stated on good authority that Beatty will be headquarters for Wild Rose District as soon as railroad reaches this point. The distance from Beatty to Wild Rose District is 40 miles shorter

than from Johannesburg, and the roads are fully as good from this direction.

An auto road will be constructed from Boundary Canyon, on Death Valley side of the Funeral Range, to Wild Rose. Water is to be piped from Daylight Springs, also from Hole in the Rock to the road.

The Wild Rose Mining Company is more fortunate than any other operating properties in the district, having fine springs on their property.

A power plant is now projected, to be installed on the east slope of Telescope Peak. Electric power will be generated and conducted to the mines of the Wild Rose District.

#### THE SULLIVAN PARTY

The auto party consisting of L. M. Sullivan, President of the Sullivan Trust Company, Goldfield; Jack Campbell, James Hopper, E. S. Chafey and G. N. McCullough, has just returned from the Wild Rose District. They are very enthusiastic over the conditions in the district, and freely predict a record breaking boom for Wild Rose this fall.

Development work will begin on the Oddie Group, east slope of the Panamint, near the Wild Rose Company's property. They have an immense quartz ledge giving high assays.
