

# WILD ROSE

## Big Increase in the Travel of Late

J. V. Lukov, the Rhyolite merchant, returned Wednesday from a trip of inspection to the Emigrant springs and Wild Rose section. While there the miners showed Mr. Lukov so much gold and so many high grade ledges, that he considers the district one of the best he has ever seen. He states it is impossible to understand how the rush has held off this long.

A letter received recently from W. B. Gray, superintendent of the Wild Rose company, states the tunnel is in 65 feet and has about 30 feet more to go to strike the shoot. The tunnel has been on the ledge from the mouth in, but the objective point is the shoot where the richest ore was opened up on the surface. The values in the tunnel have doubled in the last thirty days, and Mr. Gray adds he will be sacking high grade before the shoot is reached.

The Last Hikes company has been working a force of surveyors on its large group of claims, and are now arranging to lease the greater part of

the ground. The rich ore on the surface makes the entire district a fine field for the leaser.

The Granite Contact has sent down several miners, and will soon be working a large force. The Granite Contact adjoins the Skidoo and will be one of the shippers when the Borax Smith road reaches there.

The Skidoo is working an increased force and Manager Hoveck is putting on every man that drops into camp looking for employment. The mine improves daily, and will be a heavy producer when the mill is erected.

The travel into this section has been heavier this week than it has ever been before, and if continues will be a rush.

### County Divission

Lincoln county will not accept the proposed bill of Senator Stewart, which makes Las Vegas and Searchlight the tail of a new county kite. Nye is large enough for two counties, and should be divided by a line running east and west through the center. Lincoln division will be made in the same manner.

# GREENWATER

## Many New Strikes In Copper Camp

J. J. Fagan returned Wednesday from a brief visit to Greenwater. He received word the latter part of last week that his brother had made a big strike three miles east of the Kunze camp in the low foot hills, and wishing to confirm it and to see the country as well, he decided to go. He states he was more than repaid for his time and considers it the greatest copper country he has ever seen.

Mr. Fagan says the new part of the district, Willow Creek, is coming to the front with new strikes daily, and important discoveries have also been recently made in the eastern portion of the belt. The Kimball stage is doing a rushing business, being overloaded each trip. The sidings at Amargosa are buried with freight and sufficient teams are lacking to take it in.

The Clark shaft is down 260 feet, but is not sinking at present. The hoist, deemed too light for the heavy work of the future, is being moved to another point and the foundation enlarged and made ready for a much more powerful

hoist now en route to the mine.

The property known as the Kunze group will soon be in the hands of the developer, and it is understood will be opened by a half dozen shafts. This is one of the best properties there.

At present there are two townsites in the district, one at each the Kunze and Ramsey properties. About 125 people have settled at each and honors are even. Feed and water for both man and beast are plentiful. Accommodations are good, and prices with the exception of a few articles, compare favorably with Beatty.

The Greenwater and Death Valley Copper company has ordered three hoists, and as soon as delivered will be installed at as many different points. Portable houses have also been ordered and will be used by the employees.

### Fair Play

The coming Legislature should enact a law to prevent railroads from charging rates high enough to pay the cost of the road the first year of construction as the Tonopah railroad did. Give the miners and merchants reasonable rates and Nevada will continue to develop. Do not send a weakling to the Legislature, no matter what party he may belong to.
