SEARCHLIGHT

Real Estate Fakery Start Many Townsites

Searchlight is about to suffer from the onslaughts of a coterie of overzealous real estate fakery. During the past year realty values have been steadily climbing and many thousands have been invested in new buildings and permanent structures. The Searchlight of today is a fast growing camp and gives every promise of being a permanent factor in the mining industry of Southern Nevada. Like a mushroom field, the desert to the west of Searchlight, for a distance of from three to five miles is being platted for townsites. The only possibility of there being any activity in that district outside of the mining, is the fact that the railroad will have its freight yards within their borders.

An evidence of the fact that Searchlighters do not take any stock in any of the proposed townsites is shown by the enlargement of the light and water systems the completion of the electric power plant at a cost of over \$15,000 and the substantial additions to three of the largest metacastile houses.

During the month of October the Quartzite Mining Company crushed in its 20-stamp mill 2100 tons of ore which averaged somewhat better than \$25.00 to the ton.

K. H. Sanford of the Fortune Mine at El Dorado Canyon, has purchased a hoist and other machinery to open up their property. The owners claim they have the prospects of a large silver mine.

The Wooming Searchlight have struck water in such quantities as to prevent further sinking pending the installation of pumping machinery.

Work has been resumed on the Gold Dyke. The Searchlight Development Company are building a 30,000 gallon tank to be used in connection with 2 other tanks in case of fire. A large pump is being put in and connections being made so the water supply of the entire town can be connected.

Silver to Go Higher

Silver is going to reach a price of seventy-six cents or better within two weeks, and it is going to hold that price, said George W. Roberts, director of the United States mint, in an interview in Denver last week.

"I believe that hundreds of silver mines throughout the west which have been shut down for more than ten years because of the fall in price, will be opened again within a year simply because the price of the metal will make it worth while," Mr. Roberts declared.

And further he has said that it is speculative to boom market. The price of silver some time next day will be better next month, and it will steadily rise until it reaches a high mark, possibly near eighty, will be reached.

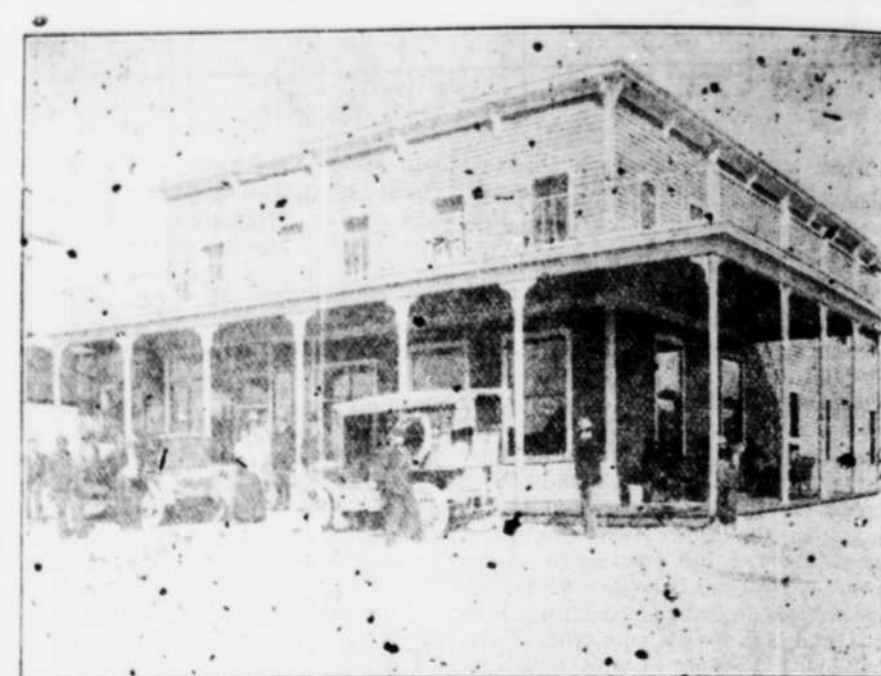
