Discrimination Against Nevada by Railroads

To reinforce its demand for lower rates, the Nevada Commercial League by its publicity committee has compiled some comparisons of the charges from Chicago to the coast and from Reno to Nevada points. The information is of a startling character, as the figures show discrimination not only against Reno but also against all other Nevada points.

To make the injustice clear to the average mind not acquainted with railway tariffs, the following figures on well known commodities are published and calculated to prove of great interest to the intelligent public.

Metallic Output

The geological Survey announced that the total production of gold and silver in the United States for 1905 aggregated 60,365,342 fine ounces, with a valuation of \$122,402,678. Production of gold aggregated 4,265,742 fine ounces, value \$88,180,700; an increase of \$7,716 over the previous year. Total production of silver was 56,101,600 fine ounces, value \$34,221,976; decrease 1,581,200 ounces in actual output.
