## Nevada Transportation Company vs. Clark County

The case of Nevada Transportation Company against the County of Clark to recover about \$1290, alleged by plaintiff to have been advanced and expended by him for the County in building roads came up for trial this week, Stevens and VanPelt appearing for the County and Leon French conducting the case for the plaintiff.


