The 23rd, 24th, 25th and 26th were partly cloudy days with more or less persistent winds. The high temperature of the season was reached on the 21st when the mercury touched 104.

The government forecast, wired to the observer in this city Saturday morning was "Fair tonight and Sunday."

A daily weather forecast is received by wire from the United States weather bureau at 9 o'clock each morning, Sundays and holidays excepted. It is based upon the information received by the weather bureau from every section of the Union. The forecast is posted each morning in the post office and at the AGE office. It is also furnished to the Chamber of Commerce, and may be had at any time over the telephone by asking Central. It should be noted that the daily forecast is for the twenty-four hours beginning at 5 p. m. on the date of posting.

the scene of the fire by the alarm were, some of them, eager to assist in fighting the fire and performed splendid service. The entire lack of an organization, with the resultant lack of knowledge as to how to place the hose, couple to the hydrant, turn on the water, etc., caused a delay of twenty minutes in getting a stream of water through the city fire hose, giving the flames ample time to spread through out the entire stock. In addition to this, the fact that there was no authority in charge of the work of fighting the fire and, as a result, no obedience to orders shouted promiscuously to each other by those trying to extinguish the blaze, the work was much hampered. That the loss did not include the \$50,000 hotel building was due to a kindly providence and not to any state of preparedness for fire fighting on the part of the city.

The fire was discovered by Chas. Doyle, who gave the alarm and performed able service by preventing excited citizens from smashing the big plate glass windows.
