### Clark County Schools

Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction, G. E. Anderson, has completed his annual report on the schools of this district. Clark county now contains 889 children between the ages of 6 and 18, as against 843 shown by last year's report, an increase of 46. Of these 334 are credited to Las Vegas as against 283 last year, an increase for this city of 51.

The total number of teachers employed in the county in the past year was 39. The average salary of male teachers is \$131.72 and of female teachers \$92.46. Mrs. M. M. Barclay of Searchlight, enjoys the distinction of having taught the longest in the county being accredited with 72 school months of service.

Mr. Anderson made 35 visits of inspection during the past year to the schools of Clark county.

### Breezes Home

Mr. and Mrs. C. D. Breeze arrived in Vegas Saturday from Los Angeles. Mrs. Breeze has been in California for several months attending to the musical score of her opera "Zuniana." She reports that the work of orchestration is now under way and that prominent people in the musical and dramatic world are planning to stage the opera. Mrs. Breeze has been working on this production for more than a year and her success is a gratification to her many friends in Nevada.

### Idaho Infantry

Sunday afternoon the Second Idaho Infantry, 1200 men, under command of Col. Edelbute, passed through Vegas bound for the Mexican border. They traveled in three special trains and seemed to be enjoying themselves in spite of the hot weather encountered. The girls of Vegas did their full duty in the way of making the young fellows feel right at home.
