We read considerable about a harmonized Republican party in California. We don't know much about that but we understand that there is a Harmonized Democratic party in Clark County, Nevada.

All indications point to an overwhelming Republican victory next November. Incidentally, we have in Nevada three candidates for the Republican nomination for the United States Senate, any one of whom will be sure of election if nominated. The only slight embarrassment there is arises from an over supply of good material this year.

The suit before the Supreme Court to declare unconstitutional the primary election law, brings to notice a peculiar situation. Two of the Justices are active candidates for nomination under the present law and thereby said to be disqualified. The other Justice was the author and most active promoter of the primary law of 1913, to which it is claimed the law will revert should the new law be declared unconstitutional. Sam Platt, asked by the court to act as "amicus curiae" or friend of the court in this action, declines upon the ground that he is a candidate and therefore precluded from serving impartially. It really looks as if the only safe thing to do is to let the law stand as it is.
