MADDUX AIR LINE PLANS EXTENSION

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 2. (AP)—Maddux Air Lines announced plans for the extension of passenger air service into Arizona with the opening of a line into Phoenix with connection enabling flight from the Arizona capital to San Francisco without more than a moment's layover at Los Angeles.

The schedule calls for the plane to leave here at 12:30 arriving at Imperial, California at 2:30 in the afternoon and landing at Phoenix at 7:30.

Leaving Phoenix the plane will arrive at Calexico at 8:45 a.m., arriving at Los Angeles at 10:55. The route will be via Imperial Valley with San Bernardino, Redlands, Colton, Riverside and Palm Springs as stops on reservation, while passengers may also transfer at Calexico for Agua Caliente, Tia Juana, or San Diego.
