TUNNEL-DIGGING FOUND AT SING SING PRISON

OSSINING, N. Y., Mar. 2.—A forty-foot underground tunnel already developed to within five feet of the south wall of Sing Sing prison was discovered by Principal Keeper John Sheehy today.
