MEXICO REVOLUTION BRINGS BLOODSHED

MEXICO CITY, Mar. 5, (AP)—The first bloodshed in Mexico's revolution was reported in five different states as the government and the revolutionists settled down to what appears to be a serious life and death struggle for supremacy.

Capture of an important munitions railroad center, Monterrey, capital Nuveleon, is claimed by revolutionary leaders after heavy fighting.

The state highway office will be moved from the court house to the rooms formerly occupied by Cragin & Pike in the Griffith building.

Expansion of the county assessor's office has necessitated this move.
