**VETERAN LEADERS**  
**AT CONGRESS HELM**

WASHINGTON, April 13, (AP)—The fate of the special session of congress, called by President Hoover to deal with tariff revision and farm relief, will rest in the hands of tried leaders.  
 The senate will be piloted by the veteran James E. Watson of Indiana, who was selected for Vice President Curtis' post.  
 On the democratic side of the senate chamber, the minority party will continue to be led by Senator Robinson of Arkansas.  
 In the house, republican leadership will remain unchanged. Nicholas Longworth, as speaker; John Q. Tilson of Connecticut as floor leader and Burton Snell of New York as chairman of the powerful rules committee will endeavor to hold the special session within the bounds set by the President.  
 A new leader will appear for the democrats, however, when the energetic Representative Garner of Texas takes over the duties laid down by F. M. Garrett.  
 The duties of whip will rest with Senator Fess of Ohio.  
 The whip on the democratic side will be Senator Sheppard of Texas, who knows by long service the importance of his office. The democratic whip in the house will be Representative McDuffie of Alabama and Representative Vestal of Indiana will be the republican whip.

SOUTH BEND, Ind., April 13, (AP)—Notre Dame baseball teams, as well as its football teams, roam far and wide.  
 The fighting Irish ball tossers opened their season at Brownwood, Tex., meeting Daniel Baker college. Notre Dame also will play Baylor at Waco, Southern Methodist at Dallas and Texas A. & M. at College Station.  
 Returning home, the Irish will play Wabash, Iowa, Western State Normal, Lake Forest and Indiana. Then follow trips to Madison to meet Wisconsin, to Iowa City to play Iowa; to Des Moines to play Drake, and East Lansing to meet Michigan State.  
 Following half a dozen games at home, Notre Dame will close its season at Minnesota May 24 and 25.

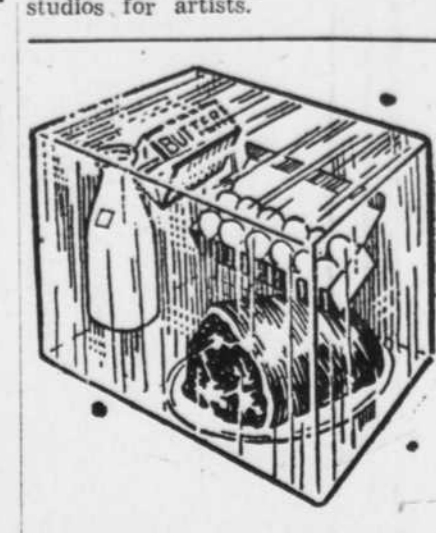
**INSPECT 10,000 FIELDS**
