

ANDY MELLON MAY STAY ON

WASHINGTON, April 17 (AP)—The senate judiciary committee in special session today concluded that Andrew Mellon could continue in the Hoover cabinet as Secretary of the Treasury without nomination.

The committee deferred until Friday the determination of the question as to whether business questions would bar Mellon from the position of Secretary of the Treasury.

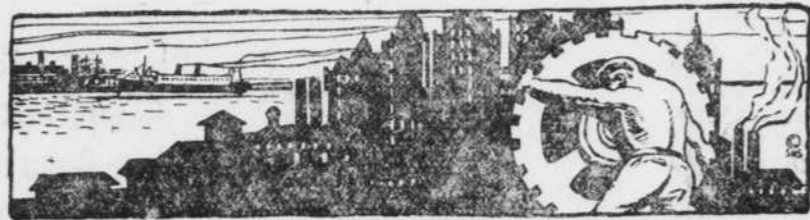
