### AID OF DAN CUPID IS EVOKED BY DEPUTY CLERK TO SMASH RECORD

A clarion call for aid in setting a new record was issued yesterday by Dorothy Keeler, deputy county clerk.

It's this way: Last month, March, saw a record of long standing almost smashed, but something went wrong on the last several days of the month and the old mark of 33 marriage licenses issued in a month still stands.

There were 31 licenses issued last month up to the last several days, but they just didn't come in and finish up the job, said Mrs. Keeler. "It almost broke my heart to come so close and then fall short," she said.

This month also big things are promised. For last night saw 30 filed with 7 more. And so Mrs. Keeler has high hopes the record will fall this month.

### SURVEY FOR R. R. ROUTE TO SITE FINISHED

Party Under Direction of U. P. Chief Engineer Completes Mapping of Way For Construction of Branch.

The survey of the route for the railroad branch from Las Vegas to the dam site was completed last week by the ten-man crew which has been working on the survey out of Omaha, Nebraska under the supervision of W. S. Woodworth, locating engineer for the Union Pacific, for the past four months.

Estimates are now being prepared for submission to headquarters, and the last of the party was scheduled to leave this city for Omaha yesterday, the first five having left last Thursday.

Information as to whether the railway will be built by the Union Pacific or by the government, or both, could not be obtained from the party.

It is said unofficially that the line surveyed for the branch is approximately 35 miles in length from Las Vegas to the dam site.

The work of making the survey was started January 3.

### VEGAS REALTY SURVEY PRINTED

A new survey of the real estate situation in Las Vegas has been published recently by the California Real Estate Commissioner at Los Angeles.

The survey, it is believed, shows what lands near Las Vegas would benefit agriculturally by the building of Boulder Dam, and makes recommendations concerning purchasing of lands here, for the benefit of California prospective purchasers.

The office of the commissioner is in the Association Realty Building in Los Angeles, it is said.

### CASHMAN HEADS NEW BOAT LINE CORPORATION

Swartz and Automobile Man Buy Out Hesse-Emerly Interests at River; Will Add to Service.

Formation of a new Colorado River navigation corporation to be known as the Boulder Grand Canyon Navigation company, with Jim Cashman as president and P. S. Swartz as secretary-treasurer and general manager, was announced this week by Cashman, following the purchase by the new firm of the two boats which have been operated between the dam site and the road end by Merle Emerly and J. Fred Hesse for the past two years.

The new concern plans to go into the field on a large scale, the tie-in between the boat line and Cashman's Boulder Dam stage rendering the connections and service better, according to Cashman. Other equipment will be added as it is needed in order to keep the service tip-top and keep up with the needs. He spent some time in Los Angeles last week looking over boats.

Two Boats Running  
The boats now being operated are a 12-passenger boat with a Kermath gasoline motor and a 4-passenger one with an outboard Johnson racing motor. These boats are being used exclusively now by the government surveyors working out the preliminary details for the dam construction, in addition to their service in carrying passengers the three miles down the canyon to the dam site from the end of the road.

Special trips up and down the river will be made soon, and a scheduled trip may be established to the dam site when business warrants said Cashman. The new concern is also looking to the future pleasure trip possibilities on the lake to be formed back of the dam with its completion.

Is Important Trip  
The importance of the trip to the dam site was stressed by Cashman. Visitors to Las Vegas and the dam site cannot fully appreciate the meaning of Boulder Dam until they have seen the site, he said, and the opportunity to see the site is one of the most valuable agencies for arousing interest in Las Vegas among outsiders.

The boat line is now being run under a Nevada state franchise, as is also the stage line which connects with it. The fare for the round trip on the stage and the boat is now \$6.50, and the round trip by boat only is \$2.50. These fares will be reduced as soon as practicable, he stated.

The stage now leaves for the dam site at 1 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday and Saturdays. The boat trip takes about an hour.
