FEDERALS TAKE POSSESSION AS REBELS FLEE

Mexican Government Troops Occupy Nogales; Escobar Trying to Reach U. S. Border, It is Believed.

NOGALES, Sonora, May 1 (UP)—The first federal troops to reach Nogales since that border port was surrendered to the government by the rebels Tuesday, normally occupied the town tonight.

By Williams Merrenger Boy Painter Wins Art Critics Praise At London Show

By DOROTHY RUSSELL (Associated Press Staff Writer) LONDON, May 2. (AP)—Paintings by a telegraph messenger boy were singled out by art critics as among the "masterpieces" of the Civil Service Annual Exhibition of Arts at the Victoria and Albert Museum, South Kensington.

The artist is Victor C. Riches, 19, who is a telegraph messenger at the Western District Post and Telegraph Office in Wimpole Street. He is self-taught, and works and studies in lunch hours and between messenger calls.

It is expected that the conservative and liberal candidates, assisted by the immense resources of their party funds, will spend up to the maximum in almost every constituency. The socialist party is, for reasons of enforced economy, budgeting for an average expenditure of £2,250 in each constituency.

By a recent law the amount which a candidate might spend was, in view of the enlargements of the electorate, reduced to 12 cents a voter in county divisions and 10 cents a voter in boroughs. In addition, there are allowed the salary of an election agent up to £275 in county divisions and £250 in boroughs, and the personal expenses of a candidate up to £500.
