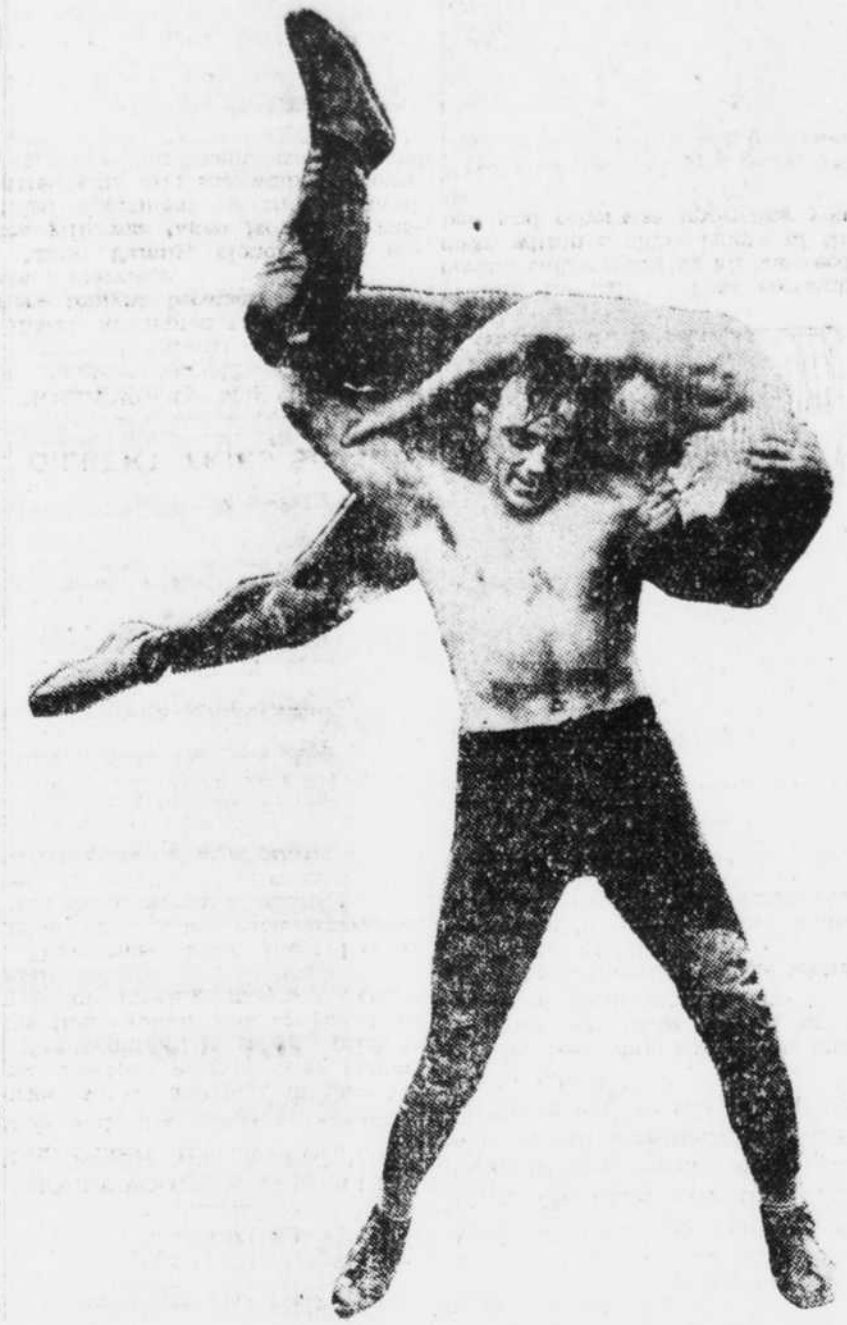
CHAPEL HILL, N. C., May 11. (AP)—Add Warren, who claims the hard luck championship among the heavyweights, is about ready to try it again.

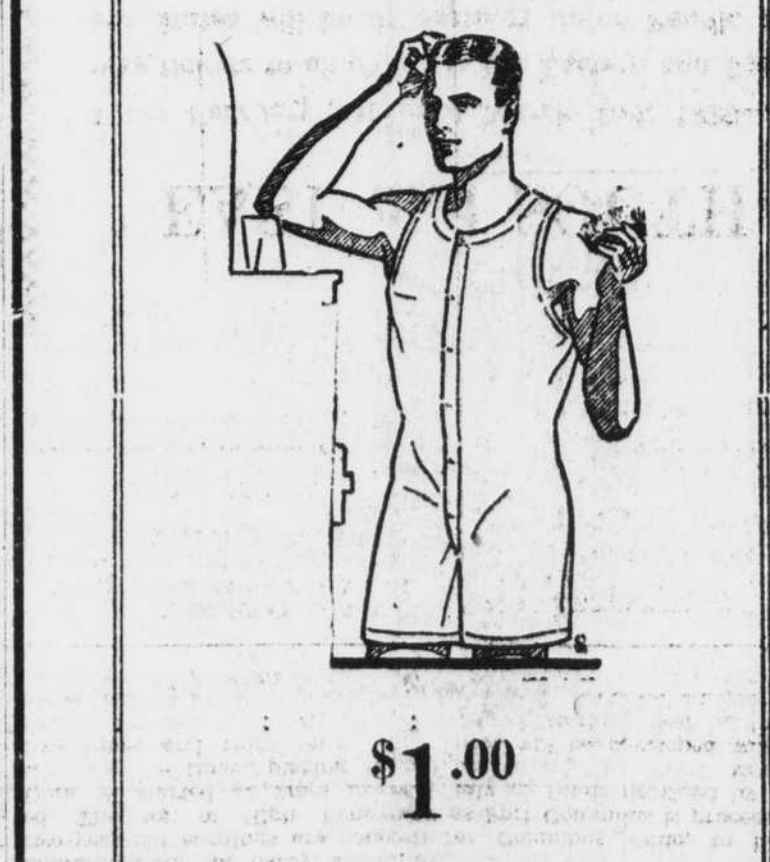
