**HILLSIDE MINES
 WORK IS PUSHED**

Two carloads of shipping ore are ready to be taken out from the Hillside group of mines, according to "Diamondfield" Jack Davis, who was in Las Vegas yesterday. Four men have been working there for about three weeks, and the road is virtually ready for hauling out of ore, according to Davis.

These claims were secured from A. J. "Box" Robbins about six weeks ago and are approximately 48 miles from Las Vegas, 8 miles beyond Goodsprings.

Nye and Clark counties have only begun to produce the gold which will be taken out here, said Davis yesterday. He prophesied \$100,000,000 in gold would be mined in these two counties, and that within the next three years more would be taken out of these two counties than was taken from Tonopah, Goldfield or Cripple Creek, and that within three years Nevada would be the greatest gold section in the world.

Davis had as guests, on a circle trip through the hills by way of Cottonwood Mountain Springs, Davis' Camp, Beatty and Indian Springs yesterday three men from the east who are interested in investing in mining property and real estate in Nevada. They were: Lee Dixon formerly of Oakland, California, John Caldan, Chicago hotel man, and J. Ellis, also of Chicago.

A veritable training ship for brutality, the "Black Heron" is headed for Frisco. It deals in illicit cargoes, worked by the passions of primitive men. Capt. Captain Bronson, who believed himself betrayed by his wife 20 years ago, and had since taught Tim to leathe women, sees his long training knocked awry and smashes Tim. Then, a storm breaks over the ship and ra orders Tim aloft to jib a sail—a job which means certain death. Real drama is confined in the outcome.

Miss Mackaye was recently released by the state prison board after serving several months of a sentence for withholding information in connection with the "bare first" slaying of her husband, Ray Ray-

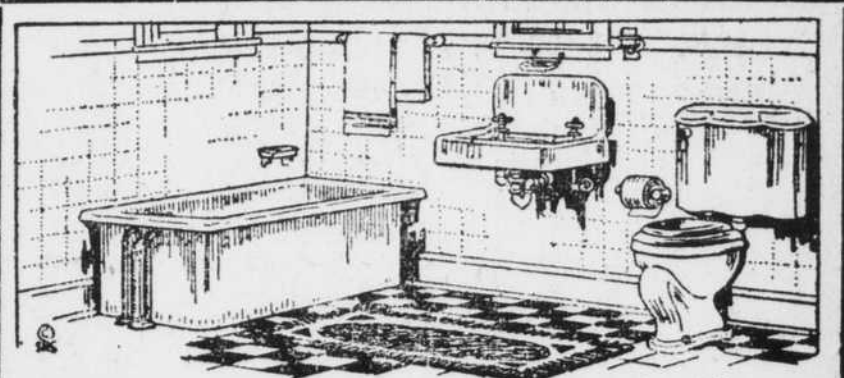
**FAITHFUL DOG
