OFFICIALS QUIZ 'DREAM MINE'

SALT LAKE CITY, May 20 (UP)—Alleging stock manipulation, persistent rumors of large platinum discoveries and claims of manifestations from Heaven have caused the state securities commission to launch an investigation into the activities of the Koyle mining company.

The Koyle property is popularly known as the "dream mine". Koyle started operations about thirty years ago at which time rumors were current that he received heavenly guidance which led him to the spot where the mine is located.

More recently rumors of a large platinum discovery have been circulated. Federal and state authorities were attracted by these reports due to the scarcity of the metal in the United States. Assays of ore from the mine were made both in Salt Lake City and Reno, Nev., with the result that no trace of platinum or any other ore in marketable quantities was found.

The commission claims that thousands of people in the intermountain area have been lured to invest their savings through the persistent rumors of platinum discoveries and has ordered Heber C. Hicks, director, to forward all data in connection with the case to prosecuting attorneys of the Third and Fourth judicial districts to determine if a grand jury investigation is warranted.

It is estimated that Koyle and his associates have interested \$200,000 in the venture. The stock has sold as high as \$10. Through alleged stock manipulation the stock was purchased at 25 cents a share and subsequently resold at prices ranging from \$1 to \$2 a share.
