


Battle Royal Scheduled

A 22,000-seat arena costing \$38,000 will be built in Las Vegas for the Callahan-Sorio fight if Matchmaker . Charlie Brockway succeeds in getting Jack Kearn's signature on the dotted line, according to Brock-way, who expects to hand the match for July 4 in Las Vegas The arena will be built on the property of the American Legion post, one and a half miles out the highway toward Los Angeles if the bout goes through, he stated.
