Great Father and Son Play Here Tonight

Father and son love is the theme of "Sorrell and Son," Herbert Brenon's production of Warwick Deeping's best-selling novel, made into a United Artists Picture, and offered at El Patio Theatre tomorrow.

H. B. Warner appears as Stephen Sorrell, and Mickey McBan and his sister enact, respectively, the child Kit and the matured Kit Sorrell. The notable cast includes Anna Q.
