Racing Craft Designed For Trophy Event

DETROIT, June 5. (AP)—The fastest speed boats in the world will race here in the 15th annual contest for the International Harmworth trophy to be held during the seventh annual Union Pacific Athletic League meet to be held at Kickerbocker field Los Angeles, July 21, according to O. J. Pott-hoff, chairman of the U. P. trapshooting organization.

Dern "Nearly Kills" Dick Daviscourt When Bout in Salt Lake Turns into Fist Fight; Boys Get Rough.

'Quality First' Is Aim Other Match Ideas for Vegas Held "In Abeyance" for Time Being; Batalis, Stoker Still Want Re-match.

It will be as good as the Dern-Papiotas and Batalis-Stoker card, and fans are going to want to continue to see the future cards."

It will be a bout that should be worth some money, and the boys are going to deserve to be well paid for their performance, it is agreed by those who are in touch with the inner workings. When this bout is staged it's going to be staged right, they tell us.

Whether it will be the headliner of a wrestling card or whether it will be the able support of a big-time stellar major performance, it is not yet known. Batalis is still undaunted by the 20 pound difference in weight, and both are looking forward to the bout.
