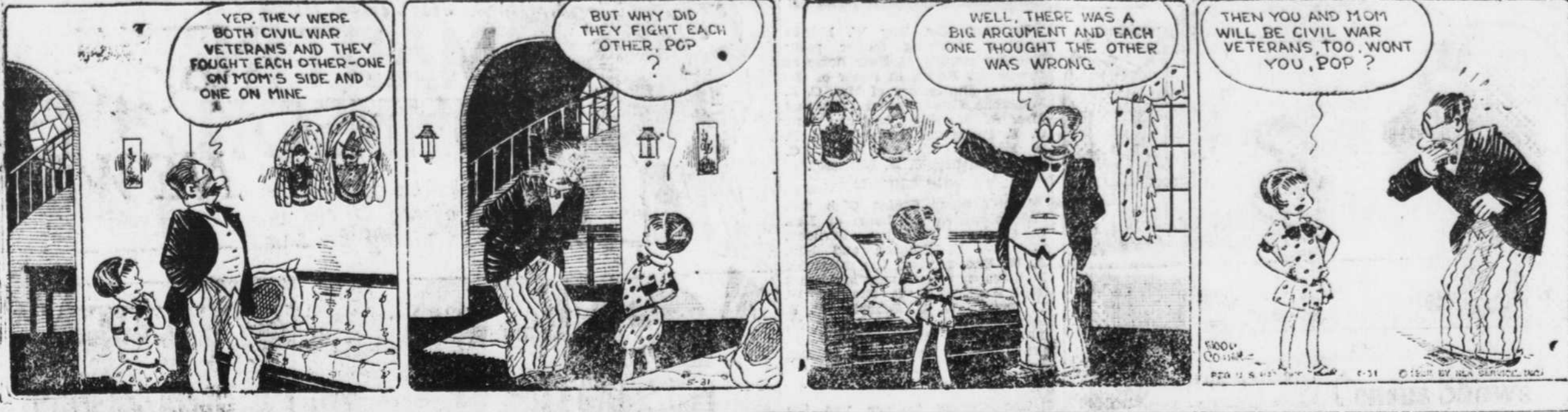

PARIS, June 5.—(AP)—The French Minister of Labor has ruled that wages of laborers must be paid in metal money and not in checks. Many factories sought to adopt the American method of payment by check, but the laborers refused because of the time required to go to the bank prove their identity and obtain payment. Census Shows More Divorces, Less Marriages

WASHINGTON, June 5.—(AP)—Marriages decreased in the United States last year, while more couples sought freedom in the divorce courts, statistics compiled by the census bureau from 12 states and the District of Columbia, revealed the trend of the nation's love life. The states polled ranged from Vermont in the north to Maryland in the south and Oregon in the west. In six of them marriages increased over 1927, while seven showed a loss. Conversely, divorces gained in seven states and decreased in six.
