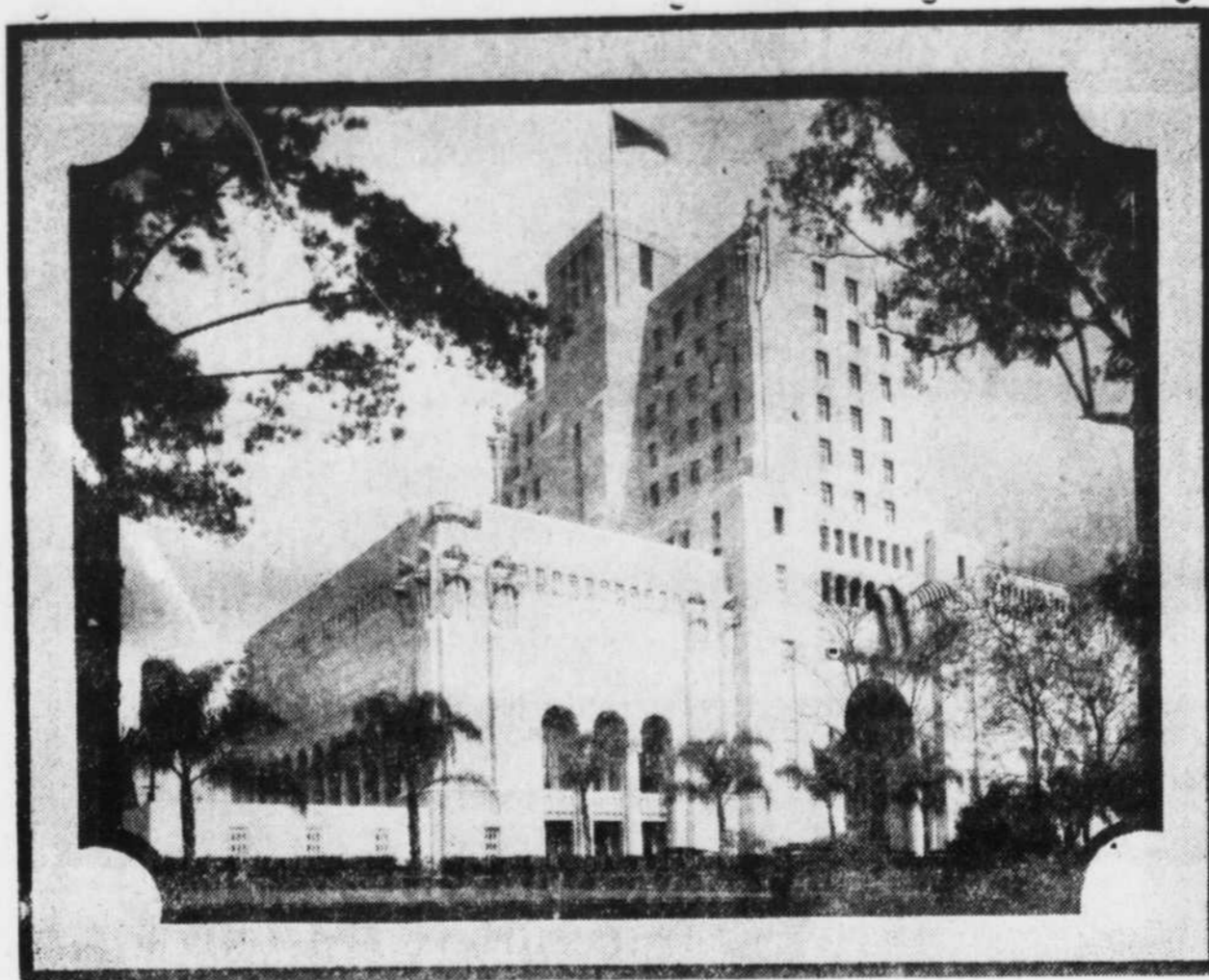
10:00 a.m.—Elks first Sweepstakes Bowling Tournament on Elks Temple alleys, to be continued daily throughout the week.
