



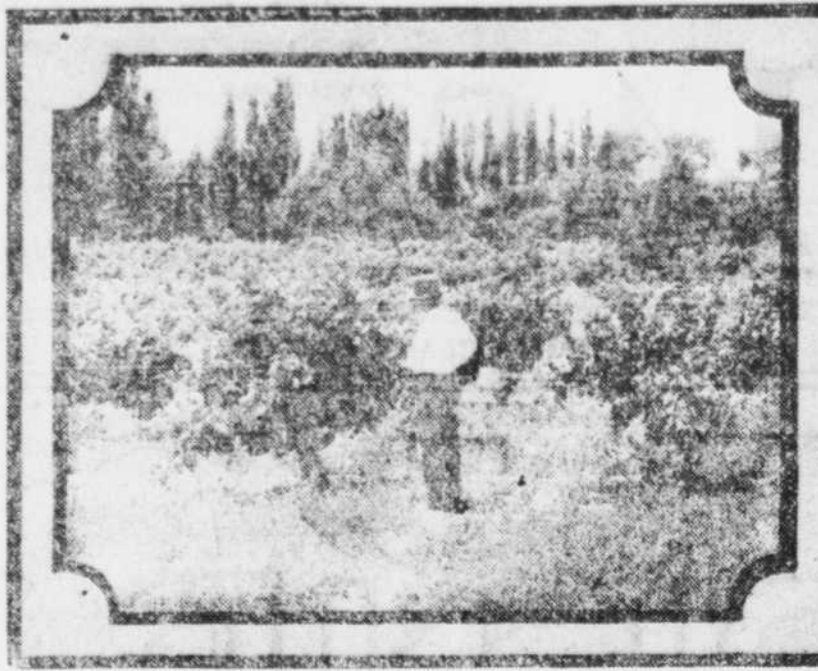

\$1000 IN TROPHIES WILL BE AWARDED WINNERS OF BIG 3-DAY SHOOT

Teams of Five Will Take Part in Contest To Be Staged During Convention Here; Five Guns to Represent Nevada at National Shoot in L. A. Will Be Chosen.

Trophies costing more than a thousand dollars will be awarded winners of the trapshoot to be held during the Elks' convention here July 4, 5 and 6.

This will be the sixth annual Elks' trapshoot, and it will be held at the Union Pacific Athletic Club's gun club across the U. P. tracks toward the ball park.

The shoot will not be registered, according to O. J. Potthoff, chairman of the committee, because a great many of the shooters have high averages under registered targets and also on account of the high altitude and the bright sunlight, which may affect their season average materially.

Only Elks with paid up cards will be eligible to shoot for the trophies, although all Elks are welcome to shoot for targets, it is stated.

The shoot will be strictly an Elks' team shoot, with five men in each team, all of these members of the same lodge if possible.

Where there are not enough men from the same lodge to make a team, they will be taken from the nearest lodge to make up the team.

Team ties will be shot off—twenty-five targets at sixteen yards for place; no eliminations, the losing team automatically dropping to next place, and so forth.

American Trapshooting Association rules will govern the shoot, according to the committee. Black Diamond traps and White Flyer targets will be used. When a contestant leaves the ground he forfeits all rights in any event in which he or she may have a tie score, it has been decided.

Local Men to Enter
Some of the Las Vegas Elks who are good shots and who may enter the shoot are Clint Boggs, R. G. McCubrey, Carl Rau, O. J. Potthoff, Dr. Wm. S. Park, Vincent Cobley, Phil Cook, B. J. Ayers, Ryland Taylor and Robert Griffith.

Carl Rau and R. G. McCubrey are serving on the committee for the shoot along with O. J. Potthoff, chairman.

The first day, Thursday, July 4, will be a practice day, with shooting beginning at 8 a.m., it has been announced. The program for the fifth and sixth will be as follows, with the same program for both days:

There will be a beautiful trophy to each of the four winning teams, another for each of thirty individuals (very much worth while trophies, it is stated), and attractive trophies for Lady Elk shooters.

Plenty of Trophies

For Nevada state Elks only there will be a beautiful trophy for each of the two winning teams, and one to each of the five Nevada high guns of the 200 targets.

The five high guns of the state will be picked to go to the national convention in Los Angeles the next week to represent Nevada in the national shoot, it is announced.

Trophies will be awarded on the evening of Saturday, July 6 at Lorenzi's. They will be on display at Davis' jewelry store for a short time before the meet, it is stated.

If the weather man dishes up hot weather for the three evenings of the convention, visitors at Lorenzi's will cool off by immersing themselves in the swimming pool. If he comes around with cool weather, they'll warm up by dancing. This way, folks! We aim to please!

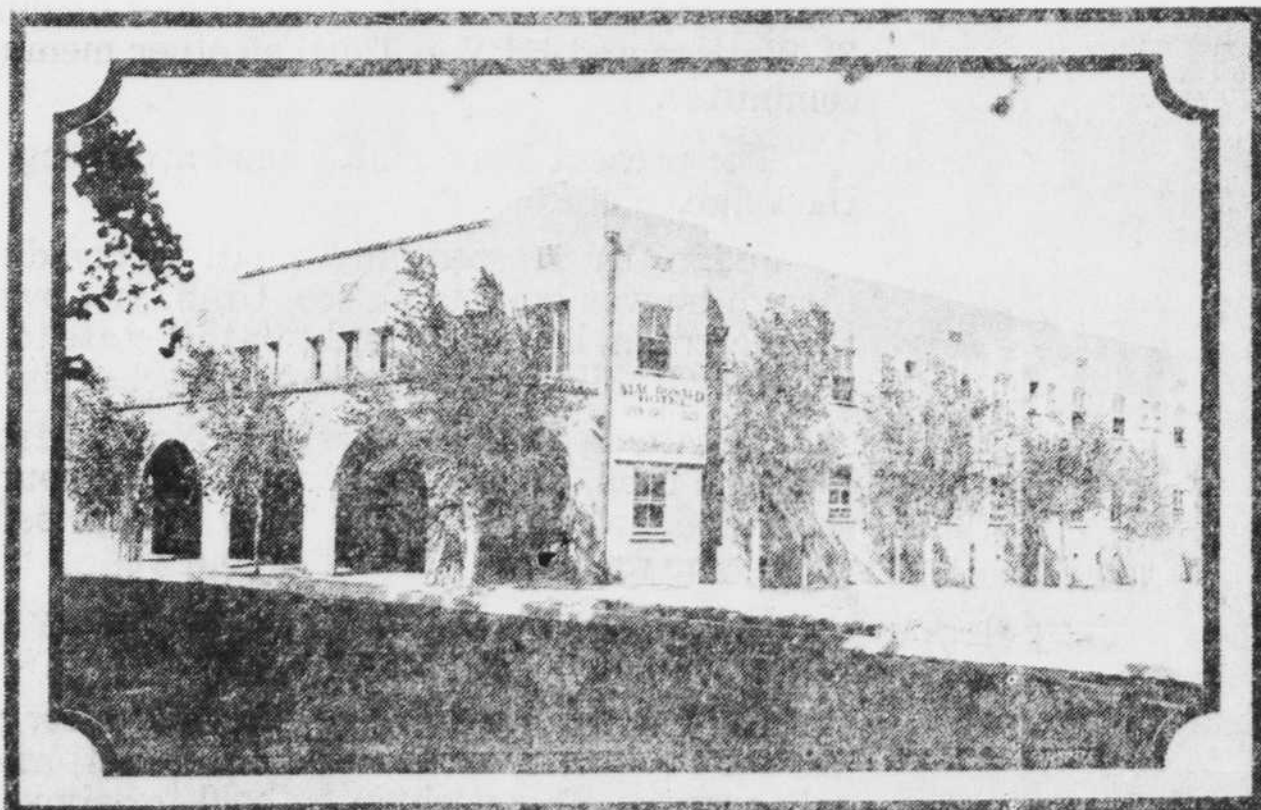
