



Teams of Five Will Take Part in Contest To Be Staged During Convention Here: Five Guns to Represent Nevada at National Shoot in L. A. Will Be Chosen.

Trophies costing more than a thousand dollars will be awarded winners of the trapshoot to be held during the Elks' convention here July 4, 5 and 6.

This will be the sixth annual Elks' trapshoot, and it will be held at the Union Pacific Athletic Club's gun ciub across the U. P. tracks toward the ball park.

The shoot will not be registered, according to O. J. Potthoff, chairman of the committee, because a great many of the shooters have high averages under registered targets and also on account of the high altitude and the bright sunlight, which may affect their season average materially.


