



Trouble started recently when a Parisienne steped out of her bathhouse with her latest Paris crea-Inside three minutes there was a riot on the beach inside of ten the photographers had used up all their plates, and inside of an hour there were a dozen exact duplicates of the suit.

It really wasn't a bathing suit at all, itw as more like a collection of a dozen bits of cloth held together with golden strands. There were pieces here and there where they could do the most good and they were kept in place by bands of golden web.
